Does English still borrow words from other languages?

Every speaker of a language has a slightly different vocabulary English speakers living in New Zealand are likely to be familiar with a wider range of words of Maori origin, like Pakeha, a New Zealander of European descent, formed in German in 1830 (from Latin elements), and then borrowed into English in 1835
